BRIEF LVWC HISTORY: The Lehigh Valley WC is a 501-C-3 Non-profit Athletic Club that was first incorporated with the state of PA in 1999 as the Lehigh Valley Athletic Club to teach and practice talented athletes within a 50 mile radius of Bethlehem, PA. In 2016, the LVAC changed its name to Lehigh Valley Wrestling Club to reflect its singular focus on training wrestlers of all ages.

Goals: include conducting Clinics & Offer World Class Teaching & Training Opportunities as a recognized Regional Training Center for USA Wrestling. Instruction is provided at Fall, Winter, Spring clinics, with members encouraged to participate in events regionally, nationally and internationally.

Overseers: the LVWC is overseen by a Board of Directors (coaches, local club leaders, local business leaders), and run by a Head Coach and a Director of Development & Public Relations. The director oversees an Annual Fund which ranks Top 5 nationally among colleges affiliated with such regional clubs, including Penn St, Iowa, Cornell, Minnesota & Arizona State.

Long Range Goal: The goal of the LVWC is to field a resident competitive elite post-grad team (one per Olympic weight) vying for positions on the United States Olympic team. Indirect benefits include attractiveness to recruits and superior training for HS/college athletes.
