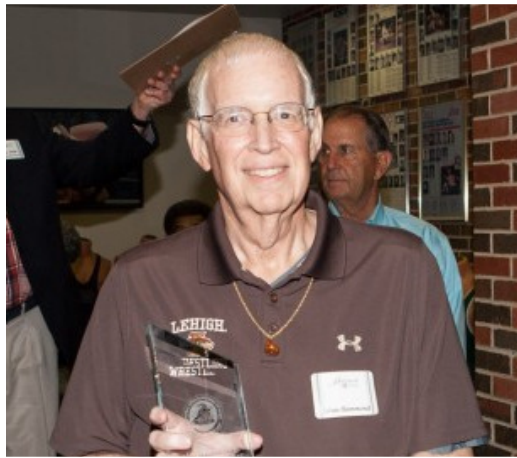


**LU RECRUIT/NHSCA Champion, EDMOND RUTH**

Still a high school senior from Susquehanna Township, PA he owns PIAA state titles at 152 as a sophomore and 170 pounds as a junior. Many remember his brother Edward Ruth, a PSU 3-time NCAA Champion and current MMA Belator Fighter. Edmond is projected as a collegiate 174/184 pound wrestler with a bright future.
